- RANK AND POSITION:** Assistant/Associate Professor of Economics
- EFFECTIVE DATE:** January 1, 2010

- AREAS OF SPECIALIZATION:** Economics
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Applicants for this tenure-track position should possess collegiate teaching experience and a Doctorate degree in Economics. Evidence of scholarly professional activities, i.e., in-field research publication, grant writing and other external funding opportunity, is required. Doctorate degree candidates (ABD) will be considered.
- MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES:** The individual filling this position will teach undergraduate and graduate courses in Economics (and possibly Health Economics), advise students, serve on departmental and university committees, participate in university functions as well as continue scholarship, performing professional community service and other duties as assigned.
- THE INSTITUTION:** Albany State University is fully accredited by the SACS and a unit of the University System of Georgia. The College of Business currently has twenty (20) full-time faculty members, it is fully accredited by the ACBSP and pursuing accreditation by the AACSB-International. The College of Business offers the Bachelor of Science degrees in Accounting, Business Information Systems, Business Management, Healthcare Management, and Marketing. Also, it offers a minor in International Business and the Master of Business Administration degree.
