QUALIFICATIONS: Doctoral degree in Nursing or related field preferred. Master's degree in Nursing (certification as an FNP desired) and teaching experience in medical-surgical/adult health nursing required. Preference given to applicants with experience in curriculum development and implementation, and in online teaching. Evidence of scholarly professional activities, i.e. grant writing and other external funding opportunities, publishing and research required.

MAJOR

RESPONSIBILITIES: Faculty responsibilities include classroom and clinical teaching in the graduate and undergraduate programs. Expected teaching load per semester is 9-12 hours. Faculty members are expected to engage in collaborative efforts, student advisement, and in scholarly activities.

THE INSTITUTION: Albany State University is a fully accredited unit of the University System of Georgia. The Nursing Program is accredited by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission. The Master of Science in Nursing Program offers Nursing Educator and Family Nurse Practitioner concentrations.
