

## Announcement of Position

- Rank and Position: Assistant/Associate Professor of Middle Grades Education
- Effective Date: January 1, 2010
- Salary: Commensurate with experience and qualifications
- Area (s) of Specialization: Middle Grades Education (Language Arts)
- Qualifications: Earned doctorate in Education from an NCATE accredited institution (A.B.D.candidates may apply for the position) is required. Successful university level teaching and supervision experiences; three years of successful work experience with middle grade students (or) equivalent clinical experiences serving children 4-8 are also required.
- A desirable qualification includes public school experience and a demonstrated commitment to scholarly activity, ability to secure external funding support, scholarly publications, and conference presentations. Other desirable qualifications include: demonstration of collegial teamwork, experience in alternative middle grade delivery systems which integrates language arts and general education services, familiarity with MGED Standards and students from diverse cultural.
- Major Responsibilities: The individual filling the position will teach undergraduate and graduate courses in Middle Grades Education in the Department of Teacher Education with the and an average teaching load of twelve (12) hours per semester; advise students field supervision, setting up field supervision, setting up field placements, curriculum development, program assessment/accreditation reports, etc. Curriculum development and grantsmanship are expected.
- The Institution: Albany State University is a unit of the University System of Georgia. The College of Education currently has thirty-five (35) faculty members. The College of Education offers Bachelors, Masters and Specialist degrees and is NCATE Accredited with program approval by the Georgia Professional Standards Commission for Teacher Certification.
