- RANK AND POSITION:** Associate Professor or Professor Chairperson, Department of Behavioral of Sciences
- EFFECTIVE DATE:** January 4, 2010 or Until Filled
- SALARY:** Negotiable
- AREAS OF SPECIALIZATION:** Psychology and Sociology
- QUALIFICATIONS:** An earned doctorate degree in Psychology, Sociology or a related field, with collegiate teaching, administrative experience and research skills. Preference will be given to individuals who show evidence of grantsmanship, professional involvement and scholarly achievements. Additionally, applicants are expected to demonstrate an ability to communicate with policy-making bodies, work effectively with administrators, faculty and students. Successful candidate must impart their ability for positive leadership and supporting the philosophy of putting students first. Strong organizational, communication and interpersonal skills are a plus.
- MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES** Provides effective leadership in the administration of the Behavioral Sciences Programs; develops plans for instruction, development and growth of the programs and department; evaluates departmental activities and needs; writes, reviews and sustains proposals related to expansion to meet the needs of the community through the development and implementation of master level programs utilizing professional standards and practice; leads and motivates faculty in grant writing, professional development and scholarly achievements. Other specific responsibilities include supervision and evaluation of the department's programs, personnel, scheduling, submittal of recommendations for faculty promotion and tenure, recruitment of students and preparation of budgets.
- THE INSTITUTION:** Albany State University is a fully accredited unit of the University System of Georgia. The Department of Behavioral Sciences is housed within the Catherine Harnett building and has eight full-time faculty members who provide instruction for B. A. degree programs in Psychology and Sociology.
