Major Responsibilities:

The successful applicant will teach graduate – level Public Administration courses such as Public Human Resources Management/Administration and Policy, Public Policy, Public Budgeting, Computer Applications and other graduate courses in the candidate's field of expertise. Duties include research, student advising, and service on department and university committees and working with community groups and grant writing. The MPA Program is accredited by the National Association of Schools of Public Affairs and (NASPAA).

Qualifications:

The successful applicant must have a Ph.D. in Public Administration, or DPA, or a Ph.D. in Political Science (with 18 graduate hours in Public Administration). Applicants with experience in Public Human Resources Management/Administration, Public Policy, Public Budgeting, public service or non-profit management with emphasis on the use of information technology for research and teaching are desirable. The program also prefers candidates who have experience with online course delivery or who are willing to learn.
