QUALIFICATIONS:

A position is available for a highly motivated individual with expertise in the study of renewable and sustainable energy management. Ph.D. in a science or engineering field required with appropriate postdoctoral experience; in lieu of a doctorate degree, a Master degree plus significant executive and operational experience in fields directly related to sustainable and renewable energy management will be considered; demonstrated potential for successful teaching, scholarship, and service; must be committed to excellence in research and teaching at both the undergraduate and graduate levels; publications in referred journals are a prerequisite; should have interests and experience at the crossroads of sciences, technology, engineering, and computational science as they apply to renewable energy; the ability to work independently; strong verbal and written communication skills are required.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK:

- Develops and coordinates curricula and a quality externally fundable research stream in renewable and sustainable energy
- Provides support and a suitable environment for students and faculty to acquire research skills and experience in renewable and sustainable energy research
- Teaches at both undergraduate and graduate levels (the average teaching load is four credit hours per semester)
- Supervises and mentors undergraduate/graduate student-researchers
- Engages in undergraduate research projects or independent research program
- Serves on committees, participates in university functions and performs other duties as assigned.
